3. All participants understand that this is not a race and agree to abide by the rules of the Highway Code, and follow the advice, direction and instruction of the event organiser or event volunteers to ensure a safe and successful event.
4. All participants confirm that their bicycles are roadworthy, in good repair and suitable for use in the event.
5. All participants will wear a cycle helmet conforming to European Safety Standards.
6. All participants will register on arrival and on leaving any checkpoints.

United Kingdom Events

These are the Terms and Conditions of The Fire Fighters Charity. The event may be organised by contracted tour operators/contracted tour providers. Participants are to ensure the contracted tour operators/contracted tour providers Terms and Conditions are also read in conjunction with those set out below. It is a condition that all participants comply with both The Fire Fighters Charity's and tour operators/contracted tour providers Terms and Conditions.

- You participate at your own risk, be advised some events may have a minimum/maximum age limit. If you are refused entry to any United Kingdom based events, any additional costs incurred are your responsibility.
- For this challenge we require a registration fee payment. Unless the event is cancelled by The Fire Fighters Charity, this fee is non-refundable once you have been accepted on the event.
- By registering for this challenge you are pledging to raise the minimum sponsorship (where applicable) by the event date as stated in the on-line event brochure/guidance and understand that it is the aim of this challenge to raise as much as possible in aid of The Fire Fighters Charity.
- The registration fee and all sponsorship money should be made payable to The Fire Fighters Charity. Under no circumstances can money be raised for another charity or organisation.
- Should you have to withdraw at any time, all sponsorship forms and other materials should be returned to The Fire Fighters Charity. If your sponsors require a refund of their sponsorship money, they are asked to apply in writing to The Fire Fighters Charity, Level 6, Belvedere, Basing View, Basingstoke, Hampshire. RG21 4HG.
- In particular, participants entering any event organised by The Fire Fighters Charity or its providers, do so entirely at their own risk. Participants should consult with their own GP, specialist and/or local athletics group for training/medical advice and assessment.
- The Fire Fighters Charity shall not be liable for any injury, illness or death of any person or persons nor loss of or damage to any property nor for any indirect or consequential loss however arising other than for injury, illness or death arising as a direct result of any negligent act or omission of The Fire Fighters Charity, its servants, agents or employees acting in the course of their employment.
- The Fire Fighters Charity may at its sole discretion change routes or withdraw places on the event if it is believed to be in its best interest to do so.
- If you do anything to void your insurance, including not declaring a pre or existing medical condition, you are fully responsible for paying any and all associated costs including travel and accommodation to and from the event.
- By signing this form you also acknowledge that photographs and written quotations may be taken of you during the event and used to publicise future events and the work of The Fire Fighters Charity in general.
- If you have registered as a FUNDRAISING TEAM LEADER you understand and accept that should a member of your team withdraw by the provider's event registration deadline they can be replaced by a new member; provided the new member pays the full registration fee. After the event registration deadline no replacement members can be added.
- If you have registered as a FUNDRAISING TEAM LEADER and a member(s) of your team withdraws AFTER the event registration deadline, the minimum amount of sponsorship that must be raised by the remaining members will not be reduced i.e. the team must still raise the minimum sponsorship of the withdrawing member(s).
- For the purpose of the fundraising contract between the participant and The Fire Fighters Charity, the participants shall not be deemed to be participating in the event as either a volunteer (as defined under The Fire Fighters Charity's normal practices and procedures) nor as a consumer and specifically The Unfair Contract Terms Act 1977 shall not apply. Accordingly, the participant may wish to take out some personal insurance for the event.

Finally, The Fire Fighters Charity appreciates all the endeavours made by registered participants who raise funds in aid the charity, and on behalf of the charity wishes them a successful, fulfilling and enjoyable event.
